CHEVRON RECOGNIZED FOR CONTRIBUTION TOWARD JAMAICA'S HURRICANE DEAN RELIEF EFFORTS

Elim, Jamaica (October 23, 2007) – Representatives of the Pan American Development Foundation (PADF) and the Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture (IICA) met today with representatives of Chevron, operating in Jamaica under its Texaco brand, to express appreciation for the corporation's contribution toward Hurricane Dean relief.

Chevron's support after the storm facilitated PADF's project with IICA in Jamaica, an organization which promotes sustainable agriculture and improves agricultural recovery. Activities for the \$25,000 initiative, funded by Chevron, began in October and will conclude in December of this year and include rehabilitation of and technical assistance for a seedling nursery and emergency seed and fertilizer distribution to farmers affected by the storm, among other recovery efforts.
